Lets read John... 1:1-9 יוחנן

Joh 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. Joh 1:2 He was in the beginning with God. Joh 1:3 All things came into being by Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. Joh 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. Joh 1:5 ¶ And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. Joh 1:6 There came a man, sent from God, whose name was John. Joh 1:7 He came for a witness, that he might bear witness of the light, that all might believe through him. Joh 1:8 He was not the light, but [came] that he might bear witness of the light. Joh 1:9 There was the true light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man.

BE-RE-SHEET..... בְּרֵאשִׁית (IN
THE BEGINNING).....COMES
FROM THE ROOT WORD רֵאשׁ

which means '*HEAD*'

Everything in this word בְּרֵאשִׁית
and of every letter is a word
picture...telling something about
the Messiah. This comes from the
Hebrew definitions, from the
Rabbis and the Sages....

Why doesn't the first letter of the bible start with the first letter of the aleph bet? Why does it start with the ב which is the second letter? Because bet means *'house'*..If a man is going to establish his *'house'* he has to take a bride. That's the great story of how you establish a house. God's great story that He is getting ready to tell us...is that He is going to take a bride. That's how He is going to establish *'the house of God'*.

The next letter is a **ר** which we will learn later, means **'head'**..so the **'head of the house'** is going to be the Messiah. Those two letters combined together..(**בַּר**)..make the word **'bar'** which means **'son'**...so it's the son of the house that's going to become the head of the house who's going to take a bride. You see how it is building? This son of the head of the house who is going to take a bride...and this next letter **א** added to **בַּר** to make **בָּרָא** **bara**, which means to **'create'**..He's going to be the creator.

Now if we drop the first letter off
and just take this part...
רֵאשִׁית .. re-sheet which one of
the meanings is '*the first born*'.
He's going to be the first born of
the house ...who will be the son
of the house.. who will take a
bride ...build the house of God ...
and he is going to be the Creator.

ש is the letter for *Shaddi*...Almighty God and the next letter the ך means *hand*...this is the hand beside Almighty God and if you look, he is sitting on the right side of the ש ..by the way, this son who is the head of the houseand will take a bride.... and who will be the creator....., he will sit at the right hand of God Almighty. This is the meaning of the letters of the first word of the bible. But now, if you take this word, the ש ך that's the word '*esh*' which means *fire* and when he shows up he's going to be a consuming fire. This is all taught in the first word of the bible. And by the way, the last letter, the ך represents the *sign, or the cross*. He's the strength of the cross to. Just like ך ך said so.

This first word tells us about the Messiah, what He's going to be, what He's going to do, and now when we read what Moshe said about the coming Messiah, we will, I believe, see the Hebrew Messiah...Yeshua speaks to all of these things. But if you have a distorted definition of the Messiah and what He is to do other than teach the Torah to all the nations, we need to maybe re-investigate....The Word of the Lord will go out of Zion..the Torah will go out of the land of Zion...out of Jerusalem. בֵּית לֶחֶם *beit-le-chem* בֵּית *beit* means '*house*'...and לֶחֶם means '*bread*'. In English..this word means '*Bethlehem*'. Who is יֵשׁוּעַ *Yeshua*? The *bread of life*....Where did He come from?..... בֵּית לֶחֶם

If we further break the word for Genesis,
בְּרֵאשִׁית in Hebrew down, we see the
following:

ב = IN THE HOUSE

ר = THE HEAD, OR PERSON

א = THE FATHER, AUTHORITY, FIRST

ש = CONSUMER, DEVOUR, TEETH, OR
HEART OF G-D

י = THE HAND OF G-D

ת = COVENANT

Using the א in front as a prefix means 'in the'. As we start this study of the 3rd letter of the Hebrew Aleph-bet next week, we are going to start seeing in some depth what the Hebrew letters symbolize and as we break some of them down, I hope this information brings all of us closer to the Father. Amen?

LETS READ 1ST JOHN 1:1-4..... What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we beheld and our hands handled, concerning the Word of Life- 1Jo 1:2 and the life was manifested, and we have seen and bear witness and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us-- 1Jo 1:3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, that you also may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ. 1Jo 1:4 And these things we write, so that our joy may be made complete.
