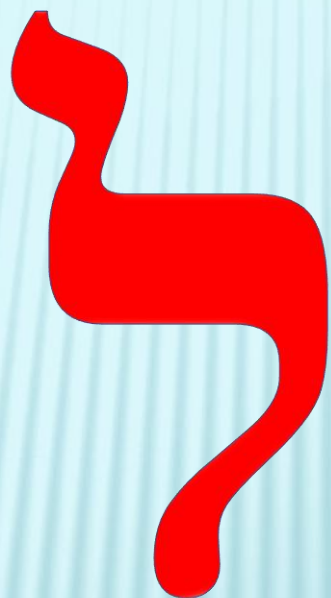

# THE LAMED


אֵל

Lamed aleph



Lamed – twelfth letter with a value of 30 and represents the shepherds staff and instruction or to teach, or teacher. INTERESTINGLY, THE NUMBER 30 PICTURES DEDICATION. AARONIC PRIESTS WERE DEDICATED TO SERVE AT AGE 30. JOHN THE BAPTIST, THE SON OF A PRIEST BEGAN HIS MINISTRY AT AGE 30, SIX MONTHS BEFORE YESHUA BEGAN HIS AT AGE 30. THIRTY ALSO PORTRAYS THE BLOOD OF CHRIST. JUDAS BETRAYED YESHUA FOR 30 PIECES OF SILVER. WHEN HE THREW THE SILVER BACK INTO THE TEMPLE, THE PRIEST SAID: “IT IS NOT LAWFUL TO PUT THEM (THE 30 PIECES OF SILVER) INTO THE TREASURY, SINCE IT IS THE PRICE OF BLOOD...” PER MATT 27:6. THE MONEY WAS USED TO BUY A FIELD THAT WAS CALLED THE ‘FIELD OF BLOOD’. ON PESACH DAY IN 30 AD, YESHUA SHED HIS BLOOD AND DIED ON THE CROSS...THE BLOOD OF THE LAMB TO TAKE OUR SIN AWAY!

**The  is the tallest letter which emphasizes the importance of learning Jewish thought.**

**The  symbolizes to control, to prod or urge forward, to go toward or forward, and a tongue....and direction.**



The **א** is a majestic letter, taller than all the others and is the center of the aleph-bet which represents the King of Kings. The letters on either side of the **א** are the **מ** (mem) and the **כ** (kaf). Put them together **מלך** (**ך**) is the final or Kaf sophit.

Anyway, this word spells MELEK and means KING in Hebrew. WE SEE THE

WORD MELEK מֶלֶךְ WHICH  
MEANS 'KING' IN IVRIT. COULD  
THIS MEAN THAT ALL THE WORDS  
MADE UP FROM ALL THE LETTERS  
IN IVRIT ARE MEANT FOR THE  
'KING'? COULD THIS REALLY BE  
TELLING US THAT יְשׁוּעַ IS THE  
WORD? HE IS THE KING IS HE NOT?

THE FIRST LETTER OF THE **תּוֹרָה** IS A **בּ**  
BET...AND THE LAST LETTER OF THE BRIT  
CHADASHAH IS THE LETTER **נ** NUN... IN IT'S  
FINAL FORM.. PUT THOSE TOGETHER AND IT  
SPELLS...BEN...OR SON....WHO IS THE SON  
BUT **יֵשׁוּעַ** YESHUA. SYMBOLICALLY WE  
GET ' **בּ** IN THE HOUSE IS **נ** LIFE'....OH MY!



**לָמַד** – lamad – means to study, teach, instruct

**לֹא** – lo – means no....lets look at this

word...the **ל** – lamed that stands for shepherd's staff...and the **א** - alef which means strong or

leading..So it would be a 'strong shepherd' so **לֹא**

–lo- (thou shalt not), In the spiritual sense only God can use this word as is meant for places like the ten commandments....(thou shall NOT's), or 'do not' Exodus 20:1-17 (Let us not forget that

the **א** represents our Father.)

**אֵל – al...this is what man  
should use to say  
“don’t.”**

**Why do we like doggies?**

**כֶּלֶב – kelev...means dog...לֵב – lev  
means heart....and the כ means ‘as’ or  
‘like’...so a doggie is ‘just as a heart’, or  
‘like a heart’. *I will bet that all of us  
doggie owners would have a prayer like  
‘Dear Lord, please help me be the kind of  
person my doggie thinks I am.’***

**לוי** – Levee means Levi. Leah had her first son Reuben whom means ‘see, I have a son’, and her second son Simeon which means ‘listen or harken’..maybe G-d will ‘hear’ her cry because Jacob doesn’t love her. And her third son Levi means to accompany, and Leah is wishing now that her husband will love her and accompany her. (What does the tribe of Levi do?) Another meaning for Levee is the final ‘accompany’ of a human being from the root **לָוָה** – lavah – and from than word comes **לְוִיָּה** – levayah or ‘funeral’..final accompany of men. And those who accompany him to the grave had a **לֵב** – lev, or heart for the man.

In Israel when you see the letter **ל** – lamed on the side of a car that lets you know that someone is being instructed on driving.

לְשֵׁם שָׁמַיִם – leshem shamayeem – means ‘for the sake of Heaven’..you say that when you are wanting something for someone else and receive no profit from it.

לֵב – lev – means heart..as we already found out....in a deeper meaning of the word לֵב. Lev, or heart is that it controls the family inside... לֵב is controlling the ב house...whose house? Yours and my house...our body! D’varim - Deuteronomy 6:6 says *“And these words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart;”* also God puts Wisdom in the heart..not intellect, like He did Shlomo....
